A BYLAW of the Municipal Corporation of the Hamlet of Kugluktuk to regulate the control, use and operation of all-terrain vehicles within the municipal boundaries, pursuant to the provisions of the All-Terrain Vehicles Act, R.S.N.W.T.1988 c. A-3, ss. 5-7; the Motor Vehicles Act, R.S.N.W.T.1988, c. M-16, s.347 and the Hamlets Act, R.S.N.W.T. 1988, c. H-1, s. 173 as adopted by the Government of Nunavut pursuant to the Nunavut Act.

AS it is desirable to regulate the operation of miniature all-terrain vehicles within the Hamlet,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Hamlet of Kugluktuk, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

- This Bylaw may be cited as the "Amendment to the ATV Bylaw".
- 2. That Bylaw No 207 is hereby amended with the insertion of a new Schedule "I".

Interpretation

1. "MATV" or "Mini ATV" means a Miniature All-Terrain Vehicle, designed for children or youths, and min motorageles

RULES OF OPERATION

S

- 1. No one under the age of fourteen (14) years shall operate an MATV inside or outside the municipal boundaries without adult supervision.
- 2. No one aged fourteen (14) or older may operate an MATV.
- 3. MATVs shall not be driven in residential areas of the Hamlet, except for the purposes of leaving those areas and only by using the most direct route.
- 4. MATVs shall not be driven in residential areas of the Hamlet between 11pm-7am during the week and between 12am-7am on weekends.
- 5. No person shall operate an MATV:
 - a. Without wearing a helmet, and
 - **b.** With any more than one (1) person on the vehicle at any time, including infants within an amauti or other device designed for carrying infants, and
 - c. While towing a sled or any other object.
- 6. The sections of Bylaw 207 sections 6.1, 6.4, 6.5 and 6.6 shall also apply to MATVs as well.
- 7. Any damages arising as a result of MATVs shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian of the operator.
- 8. Any violations shall be respensibility of yoren / gooding
